

Safety Tips & Next Steps After a Car Accident



1 What to do after an accident:



Step 1:
If it's safe, move your car to the nearest curb.



Step 2:
If someone's hurt, call 911.



Step 3:
Report the accident to police.



Step 4:
Use the TD Insurance Mobile App to call for a tow.

+ Safety tips:

Do:

- Stay calm.
- Take care of yourself and injured passengers.
- Move to the side, away from the road.

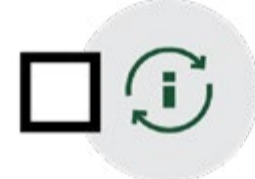
Don't:

- Touch glass, exposed wiring or dangerous items.
- Abandon the scene of an accident.
- Accept offers from tow truck drivers you didn't call.

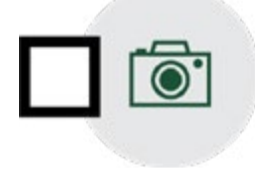
2 Start your insurance claim:



Report the incident using:
- TD Insurance Mobile App
- MyInsurance
- Phone at 1-866-454-8910



Exchange information with others involved in the accident.



Take pictures of the scene of the accident and any damage.



3 In these provinces, do this:

ON

ONTARIO –
Bring your car to a Collision Reporting Centre within 24 hours.

QC

QUEBEC –
Fill out a Joint Report with the other driver(s) involved.

AB

ALBERTA –
Bring your car to a Collision Reporting Centre and get a damage sticker.

AC

ATLANTIC CANADA –
If there's damage, injuries or an impaired driver, report the accident to police.
